NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with section 114 of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 ("**FSMA**") that, on Friday 7 April 2017, an Order was made by the High Court of Justice of England and Wales under sections 111 and 112 of FSMA sanctioning an insurance business transfer scheme (the "**Scheme**") providing for the transfer of insurance business (comprising policies, assets and liabilities) of Bosworth Run-Off Limited, Brampton Insurance Company Limited, Knapton Insurance Limited, Marlon Insurance Company Limited, Mercantile Indemnity Company Limited and Unionamerica Insurance Company Limited (the **Transferors**) to River Thames Insurance Company Limited (the **Transferee**).

The business included in the transfers comprise the entirety of the business underwritten by each Transferor (and where relevant assumed by it by way of a portfolio transfer) and all of its assets and liabilities.

The holder of any policy included in the transfer for which the Scheme provides and which evidences a contract of direct insurance as regards which an EEA state other than the United Kingdom is the state in which the risk is situated may exercise its

right to cancel the policy within 21 days of the date of publication of this notice or such other period as the law of the relevant state shall determine.

The transfer of the insurance business pursuant to the Scheme became effective at 23.59 on 7 April 2017.
